Resolution in Support of the Jobs Training Partnership Act, Title IV-A

- **WHEREAS**, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes is an organization which unites the tribal government of the Choctaw, Chickasaw, Muscogee (Creek), Seminole and Cherokee nations, representing over 300,000 Indian people throughout the United States, and
- **WHEREAS,** PL 97-300, the Jobs Training Partnership Act authorizes funding for employment and training program for adults; and
- **WHEREAS,** the unemployment rate for Indian people is considerable higher than for the general population, indicating a need for employment and training programs; and
- **WHEREAS**, the rescission bill passed recently in the House of Representatives, would reduce the Jobs training Partnership Act, Title IV-A Program by ten percent (10%):
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes opposes any reduction in the Jobs Training Partnership Act, title IV-A Program.

Adopted by the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes meeting in Washington, D.C. on this $\underline{7th}$, day of April, 1995, by a vote of $\underline{23}$ for, $\underline{0}$ against, and $\underline{0}$ abstentions.
