# The INTER-TRIBAL COUNCIL of the FIVE CIVILIZED TRIBES

## **NUMBER 98-01**

#### WHEREAS,

the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes is an organization which unites the tribal governments of the Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Muscogee (Creek), and Seminole Nations, representing over 300,000 Indian people throughout the United States, and

### WHEREAS,

The Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes is the collective voice for all Indian students, and their parents/guardians within our respective jurisdictional boundaries; and

### WHEREAS,

The Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes declares that the academic, mental, social, spiritual and physical well being of our American Indian students are of our highest priority; and

## WHEREAS,

Through federal treaty, established policy and legal precedent, the United States government has acknowledged its trust responsibility to promote the academic education of Indian people; and

#### WHEREAS,

Then Inter-Tribal Council contends that the federal budget cuts in Indian Education programs are in direct violation of treaty rights and trust responsibility to the American Indian Tribes.

# NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

That the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes supports full funding for all Indian Education programs for fiscal year 1999.

## BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED,

That the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes does hereby call upon the 105<sup>th</sup> Congress of the Untied States and the Clinton Administration to honor the Nation's treaty obligations to act upon and reaffirm their trust responsibility to Indian Nations by taking affirmative measures to **sufficiently fund** Indian education programs, established or to be established, for the benefit of Indian people, including tribal schools, colleges, tribal education departments, scholarship programs and tribal education consortiums.

## **CERTIFICATION**

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes meeting held at Tahlequah, Oklahoma on this  $9^{th}$  day of January, 1998, by a vote of 23 for, 0 against, and 0 abstentions.
