- **WHEREAS,** the Inter-Tribal Council continues to support literacy and to promote and encourage culturally appropriate educational programming for all its members, and;
- **WHEREAS,** the month of November has been deemed by the President of the United States as Indian Heritage Month;
- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Inter-Tribal Council does support and approve this resolution designating November 2002 as Indian Heritage Month for the Five Civilized Tribes.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Inter-Tribal Council does support and approve the implementation of educational activities for all Indian students and employees
