WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes (ITC) is an organization that unites the tribal governments of the Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Muscogee (Creek), and Seminole Nations, representing over 500,000 Indian people throughout the United States. and,

WHEREAS, the ITC recognizes the significant role that Tourism plays in promoting and providing services that benefit the Indian Communities; and



WHEREAS, the ITC committees shall convene quarterly in conjunction with ITC quarterly meetings.



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes establishes a standing committee of Tourism.
