Resolution No. 16-07

PREAMBLE

We the members of the of The Inter-tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes of the United States, invoking the divine blessing of the Creator upon our efforts and purposes, in order to preserve for ourselves and our descendants rights secured under Indian Treaties, Executive Orders, and benefits to which we are entitled under the laws and constitution of the United States and several states, to enlighten the public toward a better understanding of the Indian people, to preserve Indian cultural values, and otherwise to promote the welfare of the Indian people, do hereby establish and submit the following resolution:

the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes (ITC) is an WHEREAS, organization that unites the Tribal Governments of the Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Muscogee (Creek), and Seminole Nations, representing over 500,000 Indian people throughout the United States; and

the Inter-tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes are representatives of WHEREAS, and advocates for national, regional, and specific tribal concerns; and

WHEREAS, the Inter-tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes is a regional organization comprised of American Indians/Alaska Natives and tribes in the state of Oklahoma; and

the health, safety, welfare, education, economic and employment WHEREAS, opportunity, and preservation of cultural and natural resources are primary goals and objectives of the Inter-tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes: and

the United States has committed to working with tribes on a government-WHEREAS, to-government basis to support sovereignty and self-determination; and

the United National Indian Tribal Youth (UNITY) mission is to foster the WHEREAS, spiritual, mental, physical and social development of American Indian and Alaska Native youth, and to help build a strong, unified, and self-reliant Native America through involvement of its youth; and

UNITY will hold its 2016 National UNITY Conference commemorating WHEREAS, 40 years of UNITY in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma from July 22 to July 26, 2016; and

UNITY cannot complete its mission without the support of our American WHEREAS. Indian/Alaska Native organizations and is appreciative of the Inter-tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes and the support of their youth and participation in the annual UNITY conferences; and

Oklahoma Tribes and communities have historically worked together to WHEREAS. collaborate and develop cooperative strategies to improve the overall education and youth-oriented goals of our Indian communities.

The INTER-TRIBAL COUNCIL of the FIVE CIVILIZED TRIBES

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes does hereby agree to support the efforts of UNITY, it's Local Planning Committee and encourages Member Tribes to attend, participate, offer support and sponsorship of UNITY's 2016 National Conference and 40th Anniversary celebration.
