WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes (ITC) is an organization that unites the tribal governments of the Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Muscogee, and Seminole Nations, representing approximately 815,000 Indian people throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, the landmark Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978 (ICWA) was enacted to prevent the unnecessary breakup of Native families; and

WHEREAS, ICWA has been labeled "the gold standard" of child welfare policy by experts and national leading child advocacy organizations far beyond Indian Country; and

WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court will hear oral arguments in Brackeen v. Haaland on November 9, 2022; and

WHEREAS, not only are Plaintiffs challenging the constitutionally of ICWA, they are attacking some of the foundations of Indian law; and

WHEREAS, now more than ever, it is imperative for Indian Country to speak with a unified voice in support of one of the most important pieces of federal legislation impacting Indian tribes, communities and families.

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes strongly supports the Indian Child Welfare Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes believes ICWA, as a pillar of sovereignty, must be fiercely protected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes supports Cherokee Nation, Oneida Nation, Quinault Indian Nation, and Morongo Band of Mission Indians, and the United States, as they seek to uphold ICWA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes calls on NCAI and NICWA to strongly support and defend ICWA, the tribes who are parties to the Brackeen case and all tribes as they seek to defend ICWA before the United States Supreme Court.
