


A Resolution Supporting Recovering America's Wildlife Act Tribal Set-Aside Funding

Resolution No. 22-22







WHEREAS, the Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Muscogee (Creek), and Seminole Nations are Indian Tribes whose inherent sovereignty pre-exists that of the United States and who have held a historic and continual government-togovernment relations with the United States; and



WHEREAS, tribal governments hold an inherent sovereign authority to exercise regulatory authority of hunting, fishing and other wildlife conservation matters within their respected reservations and tribal services areas, including in many cases off reservation authority; and



WHEREAS, state governments have had access to federal grant funds that assist in the implementation of wildlife conservation efforts for state agencies, but tribal governments have not; and



WHEREAS, Senator Martin Heinrich introduced Recovering America's Wildlife Act in the United States Senate with \$97 Million set aside for tribal governments; and

WHEREAS, Senator Heinrich has requested an amendment to the NDAA (National Defense Authorization Act) to include RAWA as a rider on the NDAA.

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes hereby supports the inclusion of the Recovering America's Wildlife

Calls on the Senate to include the RAWA and tribal set-aside funding in the final NDAA package.
