A Resolution Supporting Expansion of the Advancement of Wellness Advisory Council to Review Cardiometabolic Disease and American Indian Health

WHEREAS,

the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes (ITC) is an organization that unites the tribal governments of the Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Muscogee (Creek), and Seminole Nations, representing approximately 815,000 Indian people throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS,

American Indian communities have great resilience rooted in tribal culture. However, our culture and communities have been severely disrupted by colonialism, loss of land, and destructive policies, resulting in historical trauma that contributes to higher rates of chronic disease and underlying risk factors, such as obesity and diabetes; and

WHEREAS,

in confronting these problems, Tribal Nations and Urban Indian health centers have developed great expertise and experience in public health and wellness, with insights to the most effective ways to combat chronic

public health issues; and

WHEREAS,

strong partnerships between Tribal Nations and the Oklahoma State Department of Health are important for addressing these disparities in health and wellness for American Indian communities and for the entire

State of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS,

the Advancement of Wellness Advisory Council under the Oklahoma State Department of Health is a body where outside experts and state officials have opportunity to review issues related to some of Oklahoma's most pressing public health concerns and make recommendations to OSDH; and

WHEREAS,

the Advancement of Wellness Advisory Council does not currently include representation on some of Oklahoma's most significant health challenges, including an expert on cardio metabolic diseases such as obesity and diabetes, or any representative of Tribal Nations or Urban

Indian Health Clinics.
