

A Resolution Supporting a Permanent Extension of the Memorandum NPM-TRUS-43, National Policy to Modernize the Land Description Review Process for Fee-to-Trust Acquisitions

Resolution No. 23-05













WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes (ITC) is an organization that unites the tribal governments of the Cherokee, Chickasaw, Muscogee (Creek) and Seminole Nation, representing approximately 815,000 Indian people throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, the ITC has realized the need for a more cohesive, efficient process for processing Fee-to-Trust Acquisitions; and

WHEREAS, on April 26, 2022, the United States Department of Interior implemented a National Policy Memorandum NPM-TRUS-43, titled "Modernize the Land Description Review Process for Fee-to-Trust Acquisitions"; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Memorandum was to "replace" the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Indian Land Surveyor's (BILS) land description review requirement from the Fee-to-Trust handbook with a Realty Land Description Review (RLDR) or a Land Description Examination & Validation (LDEV); and

WHEREAS, this new Policy Memorandum has increased the volume of Fee-to-Trust acquisitions throughout the Five Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the ITC strongly supports this policy and encourages the Department of Interior to make this policy permanent, and ensures the Department of Interior carries out its fiduciary duties to the Tribes.

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes supports a permanent extension of the National Policy Memorandum NPM-TRUS-43.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes, hereby rescinds any prior resolution in conflicts with this Resolution.
